ITEA Call for projects

Once a year, ITEA offers the opportunity to submit research project proposals that fit in the software innovation domain by organising a Call that starts with a brokerage event. The quality of the project proposal is evaluated and improved in a two-stage submission process - Project Outline and Full Project Proposal - finally leading to a selection of high-quality project proposals that receive the official label from the ITEA Board.

Public funding

This label provides project partners with the possibility to apply for public funding from their national Public Authorities, who are involved from an early stage to ensure alignment with national priorities and provide the best opportunities for funding. The label is endorsed by all Eureka Member and Associated Countries.

Annual process for ITEA Calls

- **Opening Online project idea tooling** May A set of online tools becomes available to start building your project proposal and consortium
- **Brokerage event** September ITEA Project Outline Preparation Days gathering together around 300 potential project partners
- **Project Outline (PO) submission** October/November The PO gives a short overview of a project, mainly to describe the project goals, innovation, targeted business impact and consortium. POs that are positively evaluated are invited for the next step.
- **Full Project Proposal (FPP) submission** February The FPP describes the project plan and how the project will be executed and managed. Approved FPPs will receive a label.
