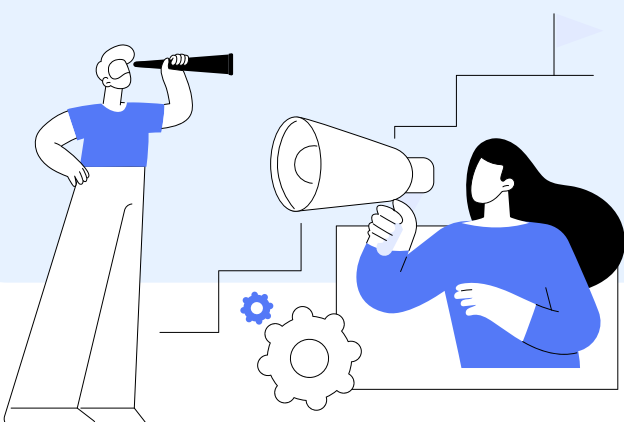

Journey of the Project

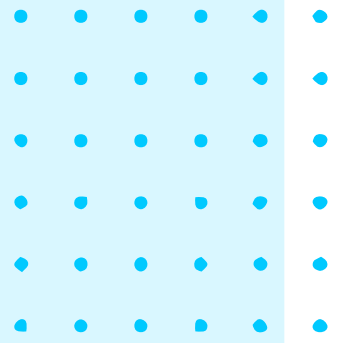
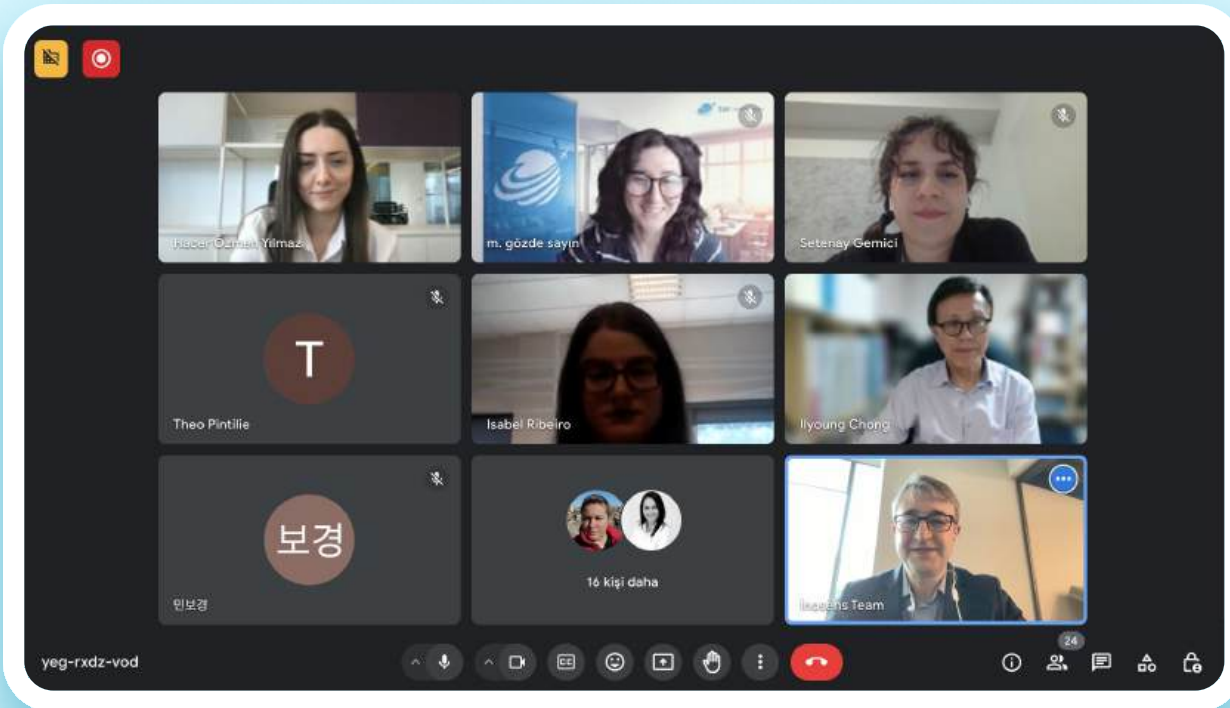
The CAPE project, under the ITEA 2022 call of the EUREKA program, successfully completed the international Project Outline and Full Project Proposal stages, earning the EUREKA LABEL. A consortium of 15 companies from 5 different countries initiated their respective national application processes. Following these applications, Turkey and South Korea secured funding, while Portugal, Singapore, and Romania opted to proceed as self-funded. As project activities continue, the companies that did not receive funding are pursuing their own national funding processes.



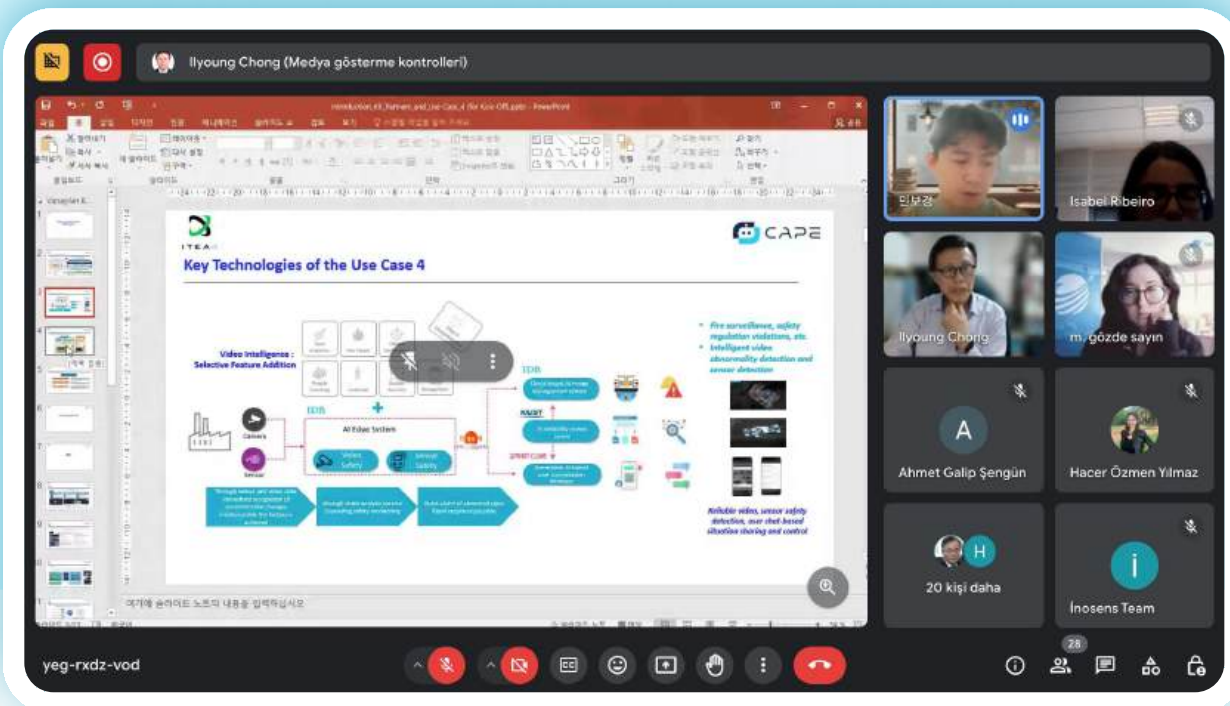
The Project Kickoff Meeting



On April 18, 2024, the CAPE project embarked on its official journey with the successful organization of the Kickoff meeting, bringing together participants from 15 companies across 5 countries. This significant milestone marked not only the formal commencement of the project but also the start of an exciting international collaboration. The Kickoff meeting served as a platform to foster a shared understanding of the project's vision, goals, and operational roadmap.



The agenda was carefully crafted to ensure that all key aspects of the project were addressed. First, the roles and responsibilities of each partner were clearly defined and communicated to the consortium, ensuring that everyone was aligned in their contributions to the project's success.



A major focus was placed on initiating the review and signing of the Project Cooperation Agreement (PCA), which would formalize the collaborative framework and set the stage for seamless cooperation across borders.

We also took the opportunity to revisit the ACTION points identified following the submission of the Full Project Proposal, ensuring that every task was accounted for and ready to be tackled by the appropriate teams.

The distribution of responsibilities for the project deliverables was another critical component of the meeting, as we strategically allocated tasks to leverage the strengths of each partner.

In addition, the meeting created an opportunity to set up clear communication channels, which will be crucial for ensuring smooth coordination as the project moves forward.

Finally, the participants shared their insights and ideas regarding dissemination activities, recognizing the importance of spreading awareness about the project's outcomes and innovations. This collaborative spirit set a strong foundation for the project's ongoing success and international impact.
