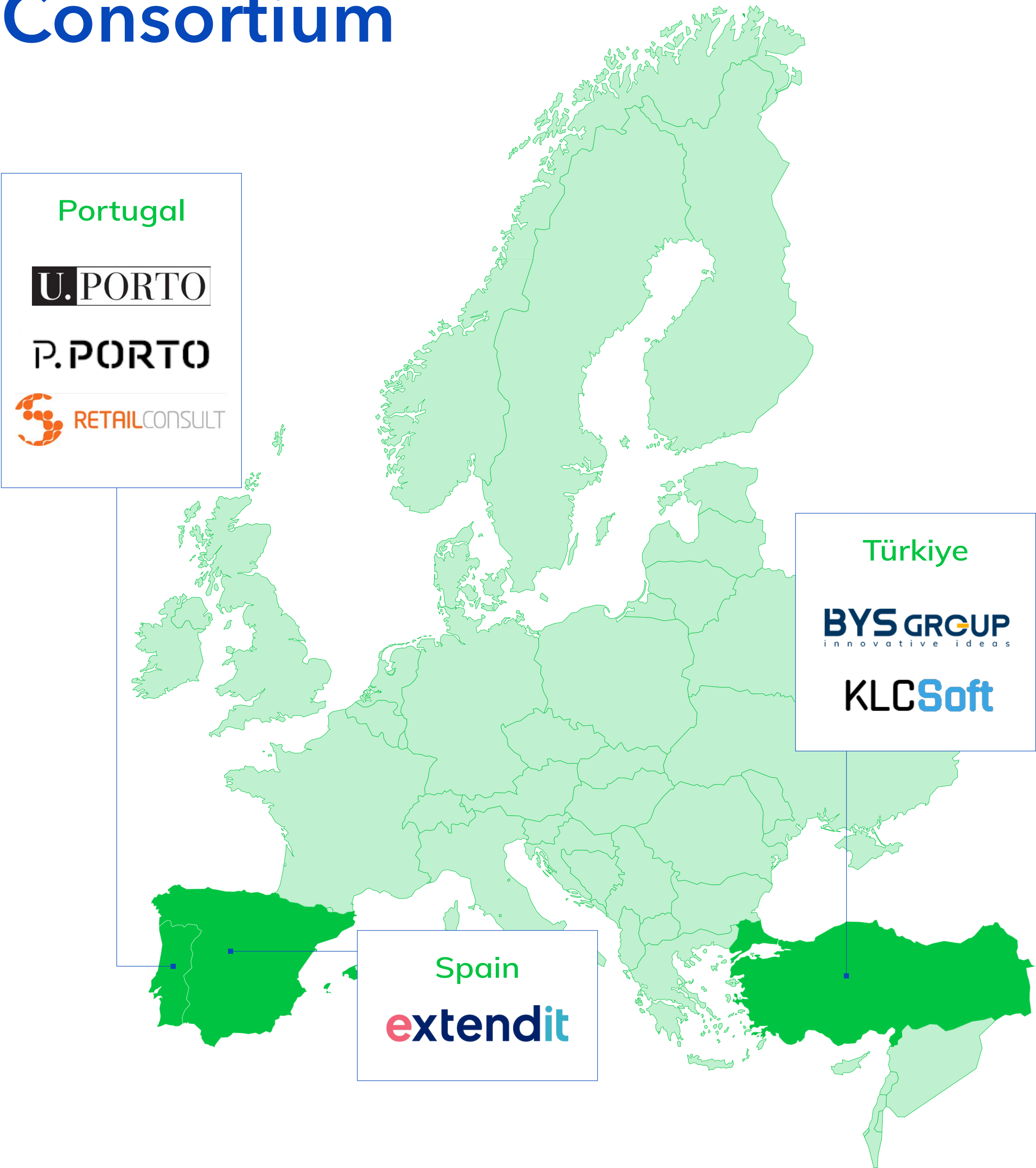


REtail using Technology based on Artificial InteLLigence

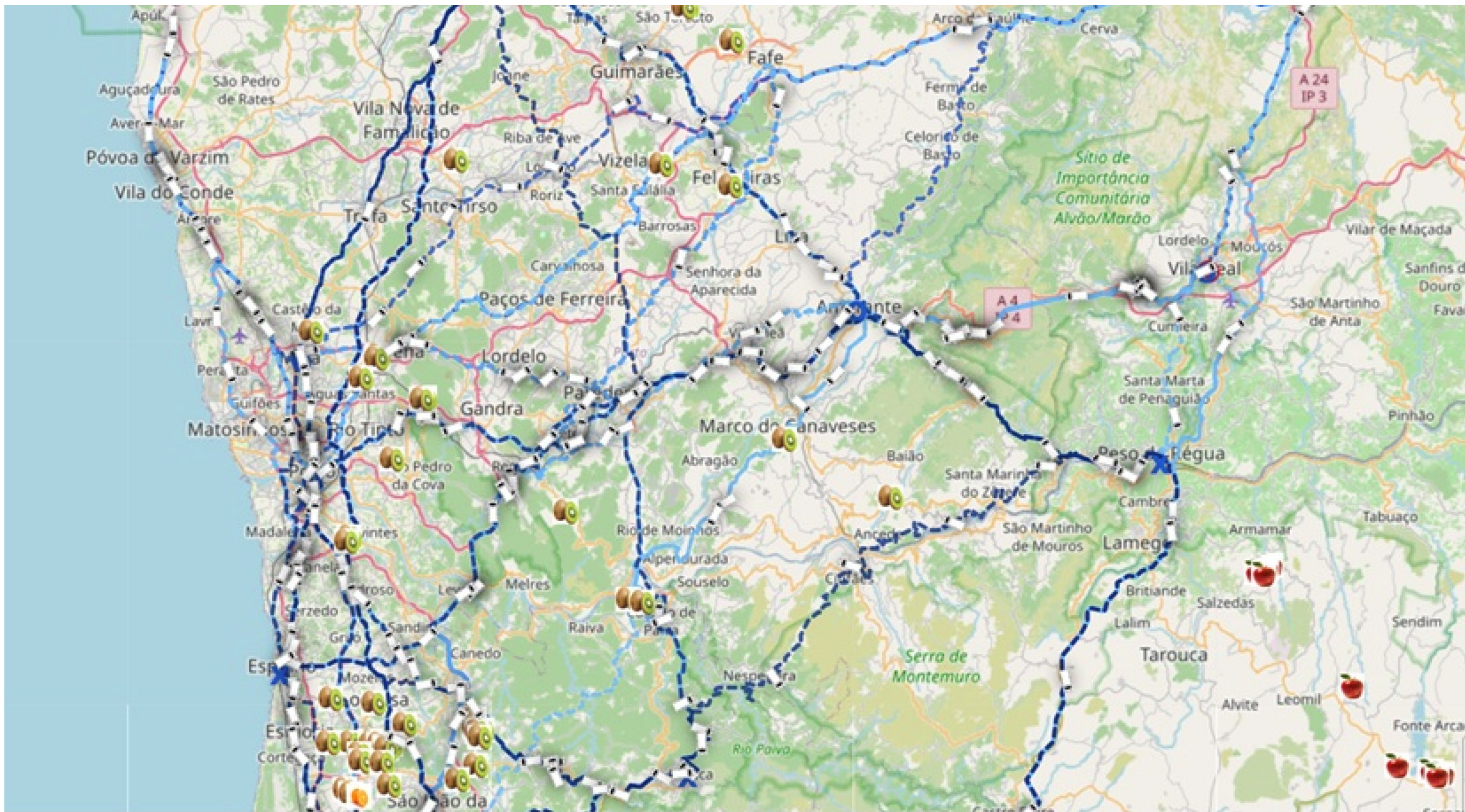
