

# ITEA 3 Call 7 overview

Call 7 PO Preparation Days, 7 September 2020

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- Once a year ITEA offers the opportunity to submit research project proposals in the area of software innovation. For this purpose, a generic Call is organised each year starting with a brokerage event: the ITEA PO Preparation Days
- Research project proposals should fit in the domain of software innovation, but otherwise there are **no** constraints on the topic of your proposal
- Some of the project ideas presented in the PO Days stem from our yearly organised customer workshop, but the PO topics are **not** limited to these workshop topics

# ITEA 3 Call process


- **Two-stage Call process**
  - **Project Outline (PO)**
    - PO gives an overview of the project idea, i.e. describes the project goals, State-of-the-Art, innovation, targeted business impact and consortium
    - POs that are positively evaluated are invited to deliver a Full Project Proposal
  - **Full Project Proposal (FPP)**
    - FPP covers the (improved) PO extended with an elaborated project plan
    - Approved FPPs will receive the ITEA label
- **National public funding**
  - When a project has received the ITEA label, the project partners can apply for public funding via a national funding programme




# Call process in detail

- 7 September 2020 Opening of ITEA 3 Call 7
- 7-11 September 2020 Online ITEA PO Preparation Days: project idea generation and partner finding
- **10 November 2020 (17:00 CET)** **Deadline submission of PO**
- 11 December 2020 Announcement of POs invited for FPP submission & rejected POs
- **15 February 2021 (17:00 CET)** **Deadline for submission of FPPs**
-  31 March 2021 Announcement of labelling results

## General rules & recommendations

- ITEA projects are industry driven, technically innovative and focused on business results
- EUREKA rules that are applicable to the ITEA projects and partners include the following:
  - Project consortia must have min. 2 different organisations from 2 different countries (one must be a EUREKA Member Country + another one a EUREKA Member Country or a EUREKA Associated Country ).
  - Project Leader (PL) must be from an organisation established in a EUREKA Member Country or a EUREKA Associated Country
  - Partners from non-EUREKA countries may participate in a project provided all participants agree

- ITEA label implies that the ITEA organisation recommends the project to be funded by the Public Authorities (PAs)
- ITEA label, however, does not automatically imply funding for the project; each partner must apply for funding in its own country
- From ITEA 3 Call 3 onwards, the ITEA label awarded to an ITEA project expires after 10 months when the project has not started within this period, unless the ITEA BSG and ITAC jointly decide otherwise

- Rules for national application submission, eligibility criteria and funding possibilities differ per country and may change over time
- Contact your national funding contact for specific national recommendations and funding possibilities: <https://itea3.org/funding.html>. On 8 and 9 September several PAs will have a Country session which you can join. They will also be recorded and made available online
- Public funding is not a pre-requisite for a partner to participate in a project (i.e. own and alternative funding are accepted)
- PL should monitor the funding status of each partner country and report to the ITEA Office on it if requested
