Some examples of successful ITEA projects

PARTNER (01 Oct 2017-31 Dec 2020)

- During a patient's journey through the health system (hospital and home), his or her medical information is often stored in multiple databases that cannot interact.
- PARTNER developed an architecture allowing different systems to communicate with each other, to enable the creation of a unified overview of a patient's status (including at home). This assists collaboration within hospitals and reduces costs while offering greater freedom and comfort to patients.
 - The system has been demonstrated using a fictitious patient's journey through cardiac care. The demonstration clearly showed the system's comprehensiveness: thanks to its architecture based on interoperability standards, it enabled the different partners' systems to exchange information.

Digital Cinema (01 Jun 2001–01 Jul 2003)

- Barco headed the ITEA project Digital Cinema to develop the key components for the transition from analogue 35mm film to digital technology. The shift in the film industry to enable digital distribution was a major and risky step to produce change in a century-old industry that required a universal, long-term digital cinema standard that could meet the needs of exhibitors, studios, equipment manufacturers and others involved in this effort.
 - These technological developments paved the way for a new generation of film distribution.
 - Now, as a result of the project, digital cinema allows us all to enjoy movies with a much better image quality wherever and whenever the movie is watched. Smaller cinemas can have access to movies of the same quality. Moreover, the new system developed during the project enabled 3D movies to achieve commercial success. Finally, movies can now be released all over the world at the same time.

- New business case & startup initiative, allowed Barco to push further into the health domain.
- Some Synergi components are now being used in existing products and currently Barco is working on new innovative collaborative features for their radiology displays based on the work performed in PARTNER.

Digital Cinema

- The completion of this project kicked-off 10 years of digital cinema pioneering for Barco, resulting in undisputed global market leadership for Barco in digital cinema today.
- Barco achieved in 2022 a #1 worldwide position of 55% capture rate with overwhelming market shares of 60% and higher in China and Latin America, a leading position in Europe with more than 50% market share and a strong position in the US and the rest of the world with market shares above 40%.



Unique aspects/benefits of the ITEA Programme



- Ideal for platform development & methodologies
- Open innovation idea by collaboration with other industrial actors, research institutes and academia (including competitors)
- Cross-sector technology research and knowledge exchange (e.g. Automotive vs. Aeronautics)
- Cross-boarder facilitation
- Large network, access to partners otherwise difficult to reach
- Industry driven, bottom-up approach & light-weight reporting structures



Advice for companies that want to participate



- Whether new projects initiated in Brokerage days or through networking, no project will fully fit your needs, but must fit your roadmap, topic and expertise sufficiently
- A good team consisting of partners positioned complementary across the value chain helps

Progress and results are not the responsibility of only one person!

- One consortium, one team!
- Make it manageable... especially if there are a lot of partners

Project Leader / WP or Task manager

- You do not need to know each and every detail in the project at all times
- Good to take charge of Task/WP that is your expertise, but not a must.

Trust environment

- Open innovation is only possible if all partners are willing to support this
- ITEA is there to help the projects, reviews/comments from ITEA are to support your project and company
