Canada in Eureka ITEA Snapshot





Eureka is an international network for industrial R&D collaboration that includes more than 45 countries

Since Canada joined in 2012:

- Over 300 Canadian participants
- Collaboration with 600 international partners in 35 countries
- Projects valued at \$800 million

Specific to ITEA:

- 40 projects have been completed, started, or labeled since 2012 with participation from 50+ Canadian participants.
- \$15 million national funding awarded to SMEs
- 9 ITEA consortia were led / co-led by Canadian



Eureka ITEA project "Medolution"

Long-term monitoring and real-time decision support in smart environments that integrate professional and user-created data.

- Project lead: Philips Medical Systems (Netherlands)

- Canada: Bluewrist Inc. (Markham, ON. IRAP funded 346,500 \$)

Digital ID technologies and privacy-preserving analysis techniques in a secure system infrastructure for medical institutions

- Canada, Finland, Germany, Netherlands, Portugal
- Project lead: Kelvin Zero (Canada)
- Canada: Kelvin Zero (QC); Perceiv Research (QC); Identos (ON).
 IRAP total funding 2 m\$.
- 2021-2025; Est. total project cost : 19.4 M€

"This is expected to have a significant impact on the quality of the medical predictive models, the efficiency of data-driven treatments, the acceleration of new clinical research, and the improvement of healthcare in general"









ITEA in Canada Team Canada

- EU countries often represented by a *national consortium* of SMEs, research organizations, and large industry partners
- Aligned with *national use cases*
- Team Canada can create *critical mass* and *accelerate commercialization* for Canadian partners

ITEA in Canada

Consortium leadership

- Influence technology roadmap and strategy of consortium
- Capable of managing and coordinating 10+ partners, most based in EU
- 3+ years commitment consider resources required
- Look for a leader experienced in ITEA process and has resources to carry the project through to completion
- Consider participating without leading
- Consider co-lead, technical lead, or Canadian lead roles

ITEA in Canada Funding eligibility for SMEs

- NRC IRAP provides funding for Canadian SMEs:
 - o For-profit and incorporated in Canada
 - <500 full-time equivalent employees
 - o Growth-oriented with market traction:
 - 15+ FTEs
 - \$2M+ CAD in annual revenue
 - Successfully commercialized at least one product domestically / internationally
- Canadian partners can leverage funding from other sources (Superclusters, CanExport, NSERC, SR&ED, private, etc.)
- Participation can also be self-funded
