Vinnova – Sweden's Innovation Agency

- We enable innovation that makes a difference!
- Vinnova's mission is to strengthen Sweden's innovative capacity to contribute to sustainable growth.
- In 2024 Vinnova funded projects with 3,6 billion SEK.
- 200 employees in Sweden + staff or strategic partnerships in Brussels, Silicon Valley and Singapore, among others.



Sweden's National Priorities

- We are looking for: Industry driven and innovative projects with a high potential to strengthen Sweden's competitiveness and contribute to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals, in accordance with Agenda 2030.
 - The projects should have a potential to lead to increased competitiveness and growth in participating Swedish companies
 - There should be a clear value from the international cooperation
 - For a successful proposal for larger funding for Vinnova, it is normally required to focus on larger industrial challenges with participation from both larger companies, SMEs and universities/research institutes. At least one SME with a Swedish place of business must participate.
 - In this call, Vinnova will only consider funding projects of high quality and potential that focus on advanced digitalisation and ground-breaking innovation within Swedish industry.



ITEA Call 2025 - International project in software-intensive services | Vinnova



What can you apply for?

International collaborative projects in software-intensive systems and services. The projects should have high quality and potential. They should be focused on advanced digitalization and groundbreaking innovation in Swedish industry.



Who can apply?

Research organisations or industrial consortia with at least two independent organisations in at least two EUREKA countries. At least one Swedish small or medium-sized enterprise (SME) must participate.



How much can you apply for?

Vinnova finances a maximum of 50 percent of the project's eligible costs. We finance up to 15 million SEK per project. The budget for the call for proposals is 15 million SEK. Proposal is submitted to ITEA.

Advanced Digitalisation is an industry-driven research and innovation program aimed at promoting and accelerating Sweden's and Swedish industry's capacity to create the digital solutions of the future, thereby driving the necessary transitions we face. >

International colloboration

The goal of our international connection is primarily to promote visibility and influence. In the longer term, the program's activities should contribute to strengthening Sweden's position as a leading digital innovation nation internationally.





Funding Outlook

- We finance up to a maximum of SEK 15 million per project.
- Our budget for this call is SEK 15 million.
- Vinnova's co-financing can amount to a maximum of 50 % of the entire Swedish consortium's eligible costs.
- Funding rates
 - Maximum 50% of eligible costs from Vinnova to Swedish SMEs
 - Maximum 30% of eligible costs from Vinnova to large companies
 - Up to 100% of eligible costs from Vinnova to universities and research institutes



Eligibility Criteria


- Proposal should have received a label from ITEA.
- Swedish Project partners needs to be legal entities.
- The Swedish consortium must include at least 1 small and medium sized enterprise (SME).
- For SMEs, the following conditions must be met at the time when the Swedish proposal is submitted to Vinnova:
 - The company must have at least 1 million SEK in net sales according to the latest annual report. (Net sales
 do not include public grant from, for example, Vinnova or the EU.)
 - The company must have a at least 3 full-time employees according to the latest annual report.
- The Swedish project manager needs to be an employee of the Swedish coordinator
- The work effort from companies must be at least 60% of Swedish consortium's total work effort.
- The total costs for project participants in one country cannot exceed 60% of total project costs.



Asessment Criteria for National Application

- Potential (weight 40%)
- Project Partners (weight 20%)
- Feasibility (weight 30%)
- Equality (weight 10%)
