

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Goals

This 2-day event will enable you to:

- 1. Learn and discuss about new project ideas with project idea initiators, via
 - The online networking tools, i.e. the Project idea tool
 - A poster session
 - Group discussions with potential project participants
- 2. Meet with participants from all over the world to define potential projects and form initial project consortia
 - Project idea initiators: Announce your group discussion sessions with signposts
 - Interested participants: Participate in the group discussion sessions, organised and executed by the project idea initiators
 - Use the participants list to find interesting people
- 3. Receive information about ITEA and the Call process



Project ideas & posters

Project ideas

- Place your project idea in the Project idea tool
- Update the contents of your project idea and inform people about the results after group discussions during the plenary sessions and the end of day 1 and/or day 2

Project idea posters

- In the poster area, all participants can quickly browse through the different posters/ideas
- This is the ideal place to quickly find the ideas that you are interested in and get in touch with the project initiator
- Present your idea to interested participants in an informal & personal session ('marketplace')



Group discussions (1/2)

- Ensure there is a discussion leader (e.g. the project idea initiator):
 - Take care of overall timing; avoid non-relevant or too detailed discussions

Discussion:

- Identify and focus on the specific problem that you want to solve:
 - If known, use the needs expressed by real customers (see the reports of customer workshops and advisory boards)
 - Identify the possible solution(s) and required technologies & expertise
 - Position different interested partners and identify which organisations have a real added value
 - Identify which organisations/expertise are still missing




Group discussions (2/2)

Wrap-up:

- Define follow-up actions to prepare the Project Outline (PO) proposal
- Assign a contact person and presenter for the final 'Project idea status update' presentation at the plenary session at the end of the day
- Complete the 'Project idea status update' presentation template and send it to info@itea4.org 15 min. before the start of plenary sessions

Group discussions – Room allocation


- You can use plenary rooms or breakout rooms for your group discussions
- No breakout room reservation: first come, first served
- Clearly indicate your project idea number(s) using the signage posts, flip charts, etc.
- Indicate your positioning on your 'Notes' poster and put a comment beneath your project idea in the online Project idea tool


