Austria



- National priorities in Austria
 - Strengthening Austria as a location for research and innovation
 - Drive economic, technological and social development
- As part of the Austrian innovation ecosystem, FFG provides a wide range of funding programmes tailored to specific needs in ITEA, e.g.:
 - FFG General Programmes
 - FFG Themed Programmes

FFG General Programmes

Austria



- Open Call, Open budget
 - All year bottom-up call for single-firm applicants
 - Experimental development, TRL 5-7
- Evaluation criteria
 - Technical funding criteria include in particular the **degree of innovation** and the **technical challenge** of the submitted project
 - The economic assessment focuses on the **commercialization potential** and the applicant's **economic performance**
 - **Ecological soundness** and social aspects are considered

Funding outlook – FFG General Programmes

Austria



- Funding conditions for Austrian partners in ITEA projects
 - **SME:** grant of up to 60% of eligible costs (60% for small companies, 50% for medium sized companies)
 - **Large Company:** mixed funding of up to 50% (funding is composed of a grant and a loan part)
 - Universities and research organizations may be subcontracted
- Max. funding € 3 Mio. p.a.

FFG Themed Programmes

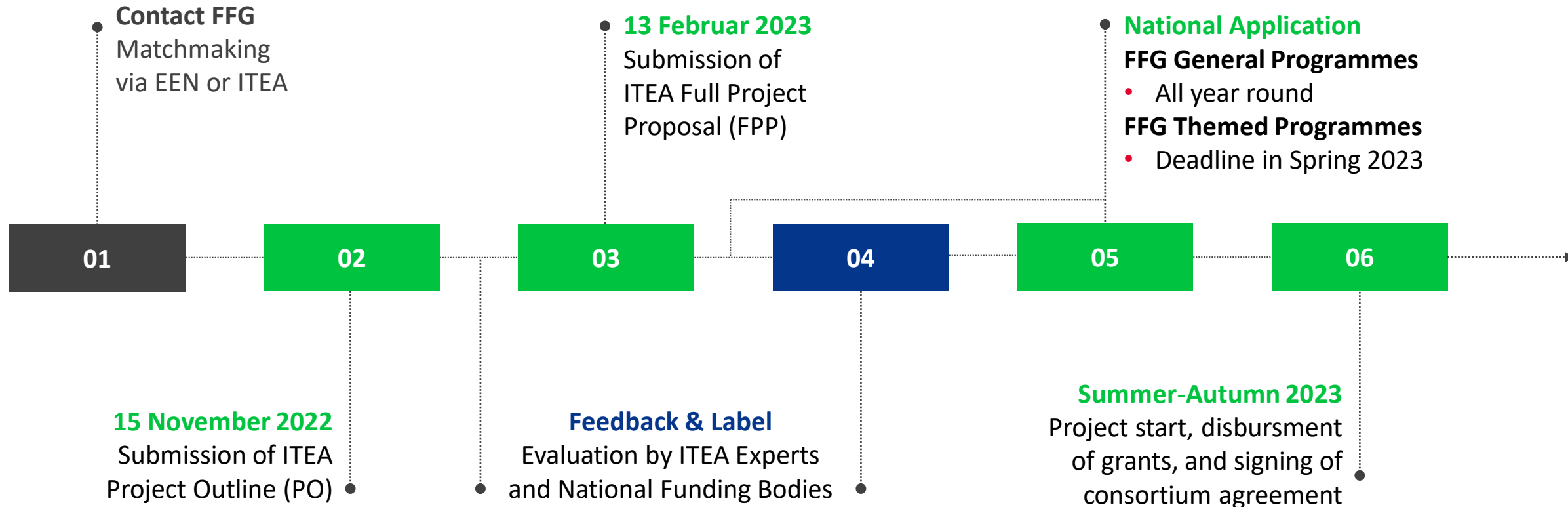
Austria



- Thematic focus is expressed in calls for projects organized by, e.g.,
 - ICT of the Future: <https://www.ffg.at/iktdertzukunft>
 - AI for Green: <https://www.ffg.at/ai>
- Details may vary in each call
 - Industrial research & experimental development, TRL 2-7
 - A balanced Austrian consortium is often required
 - Dedicated budget

 - Search the global partnership database based on your criteria
 - Express your interest by telling your EEN representative about your company, project idea, and the type of partner you are looking for
 - The EEN representatives put interested partners in touch

Support during project preparation

Austria



- **Project.Start**
 - **Features:** attractive funding instrument for start-ups and SME to get support for preparation work for a concrete research project
 - definition of project aims
 - assessment of the state of the art and literature and patent research and technical risks
 - execution of well-founded market and competitor analyses
 - preparation of the project organization and project partners and cost plan with obtainment of offers
 - Submission of an application is possible at any time - swift approval processes
