



ITEA is:


- Global and trusted cooperation in an industrial community

Countries supporting ITEA












Participation of Belgium in ITEA In numbers




Funding Rate – Company - Research

Research projects:

Base funding rate: 50%

- + 15% collaboration ITEA
- + 10% (medium)/20% (small company)

Maximum : 70% (VLAIO) / 80% (Innoviris/SPW)

Funding Rate – Universities & Research Centres

Funding Rate – Cities & municipalities

- Currently no direct funding for cities & municipalities yet
- Participation as subcontractor: contact public authority
- VLAIO investigates participation of cities & municipalities in industry driven international projects.
 - Cities & municipalities are invited to indicate their wish to participate in PO Proposals

Financial viability of a company

- Companies should check "Undertaking in difficulties"
 - Are not in difficulty, in accordance with the European legislation
 - Eligibility issue!
- Financial viability of the company will be investigated
 - Can show their ability to finance their share in the project
 - additional financial conditions are possible

- Available expertise?
- Track record?




Evaluation criteria - Impact

- Quality of the business plan
- Strategic importance for the company
- SWOT
- impact on your business
- Impact on employment & investments in the region
- societal added value
- Track record
- Incentive effect of the financial aid



Process

- International application
 - PO Submission: deadline 13/11/2023
 - Feedback : 19/12/2023
 - FPP Submission: deadline 19/2/2024
 - Feedback : 25/3/2024
- National/regional application
 - Deadline next call: 31/5/2024
 - More detailed proposal:
 - Regional activities
 - Precise WPs and budget
 - Regional valorisation/impact company & business implementation plan
 - Budget sheet
 - Meeting with advisor(s) (VLAIO&Innoviris)
 - Evaluation in a written procedure with (external) experts
 - Development projects/with lower budget can have a shorter procedure using internal experts or in an oral procedure at VLAIO/Innoviris
 - Regular decision meetings (monthly)



Innoviris

- Innoviris advice after typically 3 months, formal decision after +/- 5 months
- Adequate valorization information is part of eligibility for Innoviris application
- Have fulfilled their obligations in the context of previous support initiatives granted by the Region : eligibility
- Preliminary discussion with Innoviris adviser is strongly recommended, especially for companies with no or little experience with Innoviris funding after ITEA4 PO evaluation

- Proposal in French,
- Use submission system:
 - Deadline submission on ONTIME platform is the same as the ITEA FPP deadline!
- Mandatory to contact public authorities prior to submitting a proposal
