# Funding outlook

## *PROYECTOS DE COOPERACIÓN TECNOLÓGICA INTERNACIONAL (EUREKA request)* **funding line**

### International Innovative R&D Projects

National Consortium led by a company

Research Centers and Universities subcontracted

Duration from 12 to 36 months

Exploitation and Dissemination activities are not eligible for funding

### Financing conditions for Innovative projects:

Credits up to 75% (85% in regions co-funded with Technological Fund (TF))

33% of the credit is not reimbursable

Long-term amortization (7- 10 years)

Multiannual funding (1-3 years)

### Advance payment:

35% when contract is signed, limit 250k€, no additional guarantees required

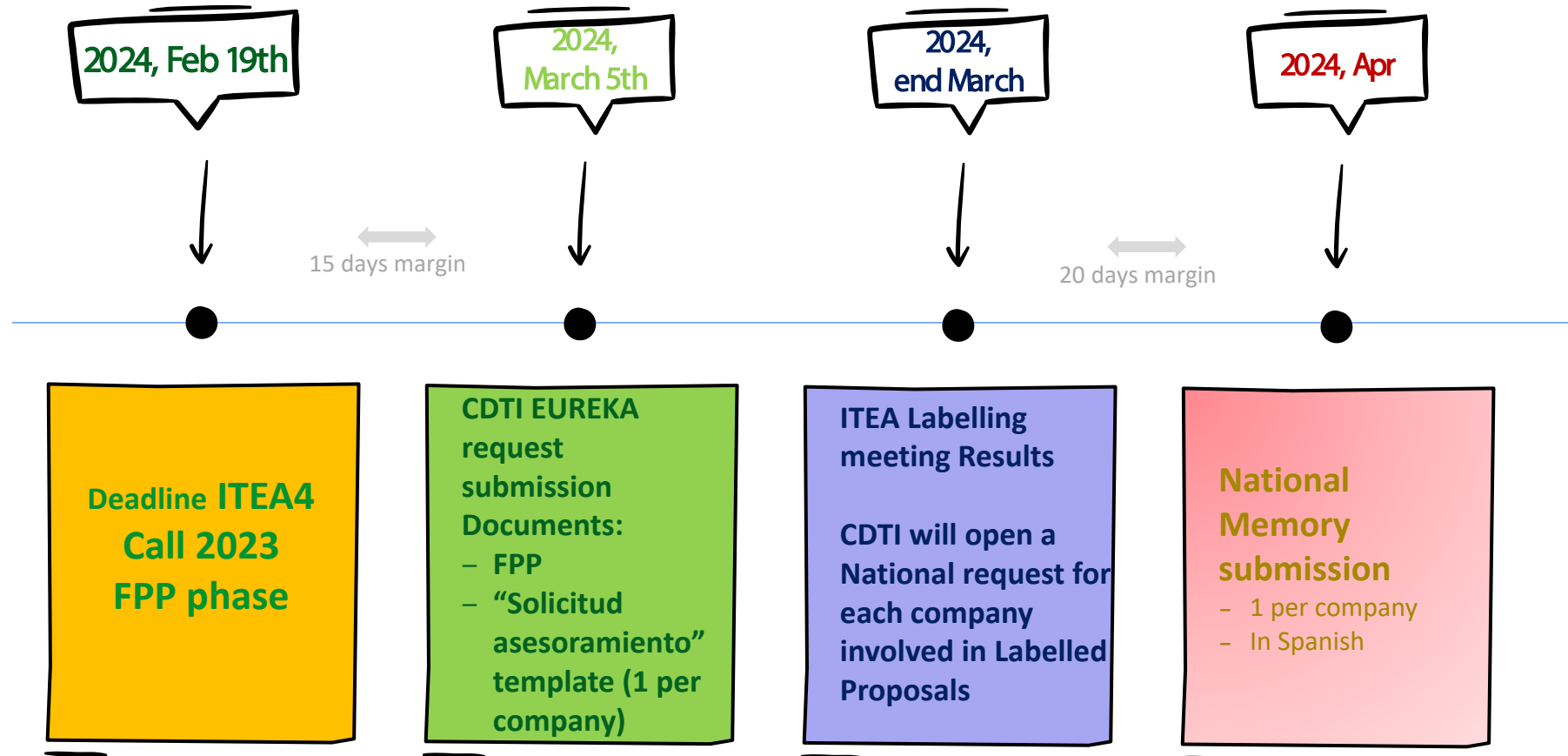
If >= 50%, with guarantees

### ELEGIBLE COSTS:

- **Human resources**
- Management costs (max 8k€)
- Materials
- External subcontracting
- Equipment amortization
- **General costs** (automatic calculation)
- Audit costs
