# ITEA Smart City Advisory Board

---

## Purpose

*The ITEA Smart City Advisory Board is established to create a dialogue between cities and innovative Smart City technology developers*

## Structure

- Starting with 10-15 representatives of municipalities
- Growing with focus groups that could be created on more specific subjects *as agile mobility for Smart Cities, efficient energy for Smart cities, etc.*

This Advisory Board will serve municipalities to:

- share their immediate needs to experts of technologies in the ITEA Community
- be advised on a regular basis on the innovation trends that can impact their cities
- validate and shape any potential products that are being developed in ITEA projects
- access the newest products that are developed in ITEA projects
- discuss issues with their peers from other cities
- be the pioneer of change in their cities by using an open community compatible with the public procurement laws

This Advisory Board will serve the ITEA Community to:

- understand the urgent needs of municipalities
- validate their potential products that are developed in ITEA projects and their features at an early stage
- exploit their products to municipalities at the end of an ITEA project in the context of usual public procurement rules

There will be several physical and digital information exchanges:

- Two information exchange meetings per year to be organised with SCAB:
  - One to discuss the needs of cities
  - One to be informed about the innovation results of ITEA projects
- A SCAB member could be invited for an ITEA project review if the project is on a Smart City challenge
- Smart City newsletters and impact stories will be created and shared with SCAB
