- Supporting the ITEA Community by providing training and information sessions during inperson and online events.

- **Experience:** At least 5 years of professional experience in IT and software domains, in roles such as Project Management, Project Coordination, Product Ownership, or Engineering.
- Technical understanding: Good understanding of the technical scope of IT and softwarerelated projects.

- Interpersonal skills: Exceptional communication and intercultural skills, with the ability to engage with a diverse community.
- **Travel:** Willingness to travel internationally multiple times per year, up to several times per month.
